### SPECIFIC SCHEMES

Strategic investment projects mechanism
<b>To qualify for this scheme, the investment must be at least 2 billion MAD and meet one of the following criteria:</b> => Have a significant impact on the country's water, energy, food, or health security => Generate a substantial number of jobs => Enhance Morocco's economic influence and global positioning => Significantly contribute to the development of industrial ecosystems => Significantly contribute to the advancement of technology

Two other mechanisms underway to support SMEs and the international expansion of Moroccan companies

## 3 Currency Regime Specific measures

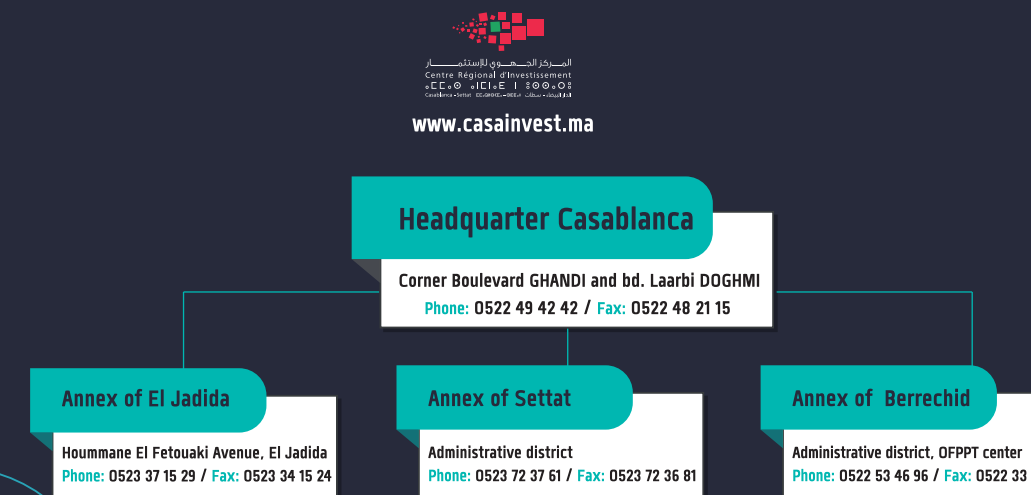
<b>Domiciliation of import documents</b>	Possibility of domiciliation on the PortNet system of a single import commitment, subscribed for the same currency for imports to be made during a maximum period of 1 month, from various suppliers located in one or more countries
<b>Import payment settlement</b>	Possibility to proceed with import payment prior to the effective entry of goods into the subject territory, even when these imports are not subject to documentary credits or documentary collections
<b>Partial payment</b>	Partial payment settlement by the domiciliary banks, up to 50% of the total value of the importation.
<b>Advance payment for import of goods</b>	Advance payment settlement for import operations of goods, within the limit of 1 million DH.
<b>Settlement of specific operations</b>	Settlement by banks of amounts due for specific operations (management services, overseas information systems, services provided by parent companies...).
<b>Repatriation of proceeds from the export of goods</b>	Repatriation of 85% of export proceeds in foreign currency (including payment of the buyer's credit granted by a Moroccan bank and principal repayments of supplier credit, net of price reductions and export commissions deducted at source or through transfer).

The granting of these measures is conditioned upon the registration of aerospace companies with the Foreign Exchange Office (www.oc.gov.ma)

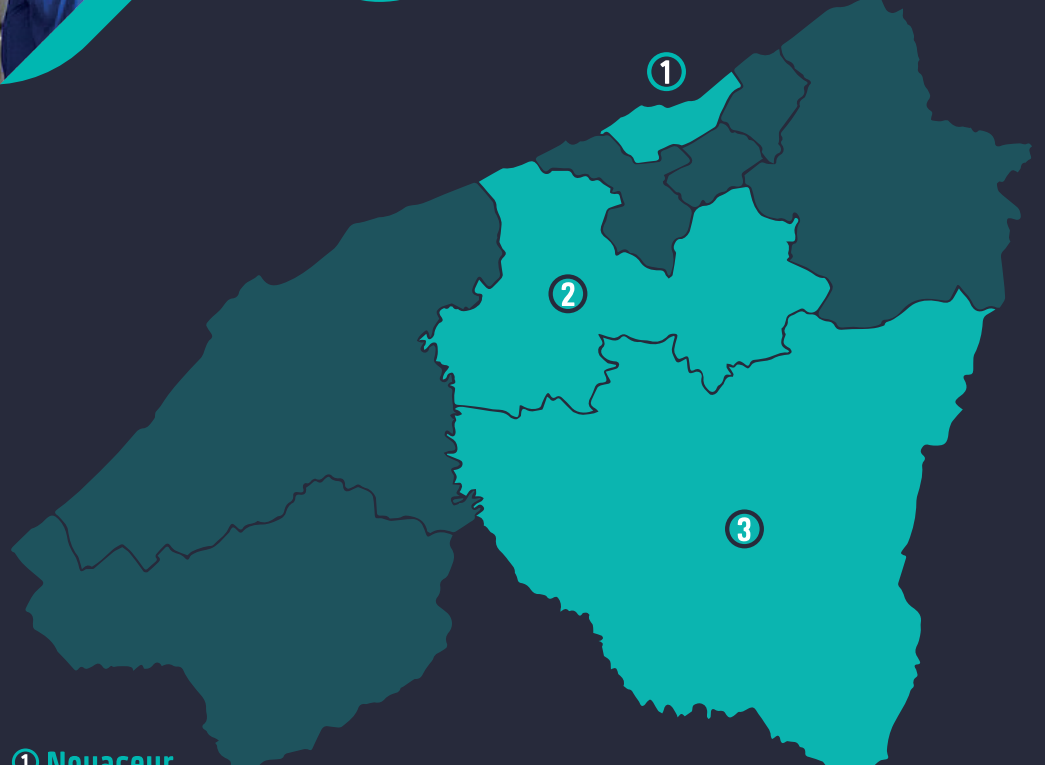
